Transition is hard for everyone, but we're very grateful to Lazy M for providing a such safe space for us go grow and explore the last 7 years. They've allowed us to grow, experiment, and develop into the community that we are today, now as they look to retire, we wish them all the beach filled days to warm their hearts.

Bearpaw has been with us since day one as co-founder, and often the main reason why Wruffin' It was able to make it through the early stages by providing the stability and logistical support we needed to establish ourselves as YEG-PaH, Red-PaH, and Cal-PaH found their feet. Wruffin' It started out as a fund raiser for Cal-PaH by Alberta's pup play community and has gone through many transformations over the years. BearPaw served as the first President of the Alberta PaH Collective and has been with us every step of the way. After nine years his health has presented some challenges that will make him unable to fulfil the demands of organizing and running Wruffin' It. This will be a huge loss for us, but he'll always be welcome here and in our hearts.

Pup Soxx will also be leaving the Canine Kitchen this year, as his professional ambitions have him looking for more focused opportunities. We wish him the best in his future endeavours and hope we can celebrate his success with him.

We also lost our wonderful cuddle kitten Voodoo, famous for the Voodoo lounge and her boisterous and giving spirit. She passed from multiple health complications after struggling for years. We were happy to give her the opportunity to attend via remote access last year, but no worldly connection can find her now. We miss you.

To our beloved friends and organizers, we will miss you and thank you for everything you've given to make this exceptional piece of history in our community. Your paw prints will always be felt.

So where do we go from here? We've struggled to find a new venue, and PapaWuff has leaned strongly into the idea of wrapping it up as well. However, over the last few months in consultation with the community it's clear that there is a demand for Wruffin' It to continue in some way – whereby a camp, a con, a competition – there are option on the horizon and enough interested community members to step up and fill the required roles that

Wruffin' It will continue on in some form. There's no promise of a specific camp for next year, though it is being worked on. This will be far from the end and we hope to keep building and growing with you. PapaWuff will be heading to Judge at L.A. Pup Competition this November on invitation from IPTC International Pup winner Pup Star Orion (buy a coaster to support the trip!) and will be learning and working with Orion and others towards bringing an IPTC recognized puppy competition to Alberta.

We've confirmed that WereDog is wiling to continue its support going forward, and has provided toys, and



financial consideration to support camp this year – including a t-shirt for every camper. A small handful of sponsors have also expressed interest in helping Wruffin' It continue and move into the future. We're infinitely grateful for our partners participation and support. For the first time since camp started, we'll be able to make some real savings for the future.

Transition is hard, but growth is always worth it, lets go chase some rainbows!

Founded in 2017 by members of Alberta's Pet Play community, Wruffin'It is a level 5 pet play summer Camp. Our mission is to promote pet play in Alberta through events and education. We do that through several initiatives such as Camp, but also in supporting local pup and furry artists and businesses, running pet play education panels and moshes at Alberta's fur cons, and supporting pet play groups locally and globally. We have a few initiatives up our sleeves for next year too, it's exciting times!

If you're new here, and half of you are, this might be a bit jarring at first. Don't feel pressured to join in right away but know that you're absolutely welcome to. Feel free to observe, ask questions, and respectfully explore. We're all here to learn and grow together. We encourage Campers to dive right in.

#### **Our Weekend Home**



We're very lucky to have such a wonderful and supportive venue to host Camp at. Our hosts Randy and Marcel took a chance on us early on and have gone above and beyond in offering their excellent hospitality and a site for us to transform. Joined by their Assistant Aldo, and bio-pup Rascal, the Lazy M team is here to ensure smooth sailing. If you have any needs from the venue, reach out to a staff member and we'll engage Lazy M on your behalf.

More than event partners, we consider them loved friends. If you're new to Lazy M, you're going to love it here. Please note that this site is also the home of our hosts and their staff. Treat it with the respect and honour it deserves so that we may come back year after year.

Lazy M offers potable ground water, treated and tested on-site, and monitored by the county. If you're not used to soft water, it may taste and feel a little weird, but we promise it's perfectly safe. We'll be offering bottled water at our watering stations for those who prefer city water.



Wi-Fi is available on site, but only in the lodge. It's slow, but it works. Cell reception is hit and miss, sometimes data speeds are better than the Wi-Fi, sometimes it goes on vacation as well. There is limited Starlink Service in the Gathering Centre – please do not stream video.

The site is fully powered and has familiar sanitation. There's a shower in the field and attached to the cauldron, please use those to rinse off any messes before heading indoors. The Bathroom on the second floor of the lodge is for lodge guest use only.

- **Pup Brenin** is our Lead Medic, a professional paramedic by trade, please respect the limitations on the care they can offer.

# **Dungeon Culture**



Camp Wruffin'It exists entirely within a BDSM dungeon. What this means is that the entire Camp space operates under dungeon rules, which are posted in the dungeon space in The Gathering Centre. In short, **consent and respect are prime in everything we do**. It's better to ask than assume, defer to reasonable authority, and express gratitude to all whenever possible.

You are free to dress pretty much how you wish or not get dressed at all. You may witness or partake in open sex acts with other Campers at your discretion nearly anywhere on the grounds provided informed, ongoing consent has been obtained and remains. Periodic check-ins with play partners are a sign of care and attention.

Regardless of whatever arrangements you may have with playmates outside of Camp, we *insist* that Campers respect "Stop" and "Red" as immediate revocations of consent. If Campers are engaged in activity where "Stop" or "Red" are not being respected, Campers or staff may intervene and discuss the situation with both sides separately and proceed in-line with our response procedures. If you see something concerning, speak to staff or the campers.

While consent may be given legally while intoxicated in Canada, here, consent should be negotiated while sober, be ongoing, enthusiastic, clear, informed, and revocable. These rules work to keep us safe, and power balanced.

## **Arriving to Camp**



Upon arrival you will be greeted by our Reg Desk team, we're told treats are appreciated. Before being allowed onto the grounds all Campers must present valid ID, sign our waiver which you can

find at the end of this booklet – do not print it off, one will be provided for you on our tablet. You'll complete orientation (1<sup>st</sup> timers only) and receive your welcome package that contains your badge and goodies. At that point you'll be allowed onto the grounds to unpack, park your vehicle, and setup your lodgings.

The registration desk runs from 2pm – 8pm on Thursday. If you arrive after that period seek out a staff member indicated by a green border on their badge. It's expected that campers always wear their badges publicly.

## **Parking**

Parking is located on the eastern fence line. During Camp vehicle access will be restricted. The parking lot at the lodge is designated Staff Only. Temporary loading and unloading in the staff lot is permitted. Otherwise, please park on the hill and set your parking brake.

Please note that at 9pm on Thursday the gates to Lazy M will be secured. Re-entering the grounds needs to be coordinated with Lazy M staff and is solely at their discretion and availability.

## Lodging

Campers staying in the lodge are assigned a theme room which will be revealed to you at the reg desk. Themed goodies in the room and the room signage are yours encouraged to be taken home.

Some lodge guests have private bathrooms. The second-floor bathroom is restricted to lodge guests only. **Penetrative sex inside the lodge is confined to private rooms only, and nothing at** 

the table. Everything else must be hygienic, and respectful of the place, people, and setting in which they occur.

# Rabbit Pit (RVs)



RV's will be arranged in the RV pit at the direction of Papa Bear as indicated on the map. There is a septic dump for only portable holding tanks. RVers are asked not to run generators, but if necessary to limit it to battery recharging and be respectful of the noise impact on the activities around the area. Wruffin'It takes efforts to preserving the dark sky experience for star gazing and

may take steps altering lighting to accommodate. The night skies are stunning out here, lets share them.

# Canine Kitchen



We really hope you enjoy the food program at Wruffin'It. We've stepped things up a bit this year. If you've disclosed food allergies and preferences in your registration, accommodations and alternatives have been made ready for you. Please note that this menu is subject to changes.

The **Handler's Honour Dinner** is a space where we encourage Campers to honour the Doms, Alphas, Handlers, and other leaders in their lives. **It's a chance to say a toast, present a token of appreciation, or just vibe in mutual gratitude for the effort those who lead us, give us.** 

Camp branded tableware is free for anyone to use, there is enough for everyone. Please return to the cleaning crew after use. The cleaning crew will not wash your personal tableware.

Do not dispose of tableware items, do not pilfer, they are made of wheat straw - do not eat them. Tableware is not for yiffing, riffing, or miffing and may not be held for ransom, lease, or used for harassment or terrorism.

Cross contamination is a concern for some of our Campers. It is critical that you do not mix serving utensils between dishes. Be diligent. Mistakes can make Campers sick for days, severely harm them, and ruin their experience. If a serving utensil has gone missing or been mixed up, please let the Kitchen staff know. Be careful with crumbs and spillage in the food serving areas.

There is limited fridge space available on the grounds for you to store medication and perishables on a first come first serve basis. Priority will be given to those with temperature sensitive medications.

#### Glass containers are not permitted in public spaces; it's a safety around nude puppies thing.

Food area/Cooler storage – The food area/cooler storage is where we ask that you store all your food, do all your food prep and wash dishes. This is so that we don't get nosey bears or armies of ants wandering into Camp looking for a snack. Cooking can be done here as well. There is a BBQ and a three-burner propane Camp stove that is free to use. The sink for washing dishes is under the deck. Ice blocks are in the chest freezer in the cooler room which is open 24 hrs. Priority is to be given to Canine Kitchen Staff and Volunteers preparing community meals.

You may only enter the lodge kitchen to refill water bottles in the sink.












## Schedule (Table)

# Health & Safety



There are outdoor hydration stations located throughout the Camp site, so bring your water bottle! Sunscreen and bug spray will be placed through

out Camp. If you've forgotten yours, use ours. If you need medical attention, please have someone contact a medic or staff member for you.

Periodically check each other for ticks, especially if having been in long grasses or along the paths.

## **Tenting**



Those tenting are expected to bring all the necessary gear for their comfort. You may not cook at your tenting site, nor store food in your tents. We are in bear country, and

# all food stuff must be stored in the storage area of The Gathering Centre.

Tenting areas are indicated on the map and are broken into three areas:

- The Quiet Zone by the garage has access to outlets for those who have CPAPs. Campers in this area are asked to keep their noise levels down around 11pm for those who like to retire earlier.
- The Grove may also be used for CPAP users
  if long enough extension cords are available.
  This area is just north of the
  Residence/Office and open to all. Watch out
  for power cabling on the ground.
- The Party Camp is located on the north and south sides of the hay shed. This is a more active area close to the hay shed and a firepit and tends to attract more of a late-night crowd.

All Campers are welcome to use all bathrooms and showers in The Gathering Centre, the portables in the field and showers in the main floor of the Lodge. Shower Brooms are for scrubbing the floors after your shower, please use.

# **Emergency Procedures**

In an emergency, you will hear a siren from the bull horns and instructions on where to go.

Make sure those around you are aware there's an emergency and are moving to a muster point.

- Follow instructions and make your way to the designated muster point as quickly as possible.
- Do not try to go to your tents or rooms to retrieve personal items.
- If you see a fellow Camper who is injured or unable to make their way to the muster points, please inform staff when you arrive.

- Do not open or explore the yellow emergency kit bags.
- Health and Safety staff have developed response procedures anticipating multiple types of scenarios,



In most cases, in an emergency, head to muster point 1 unless otherwise directed. Muster points are located:

- 1. At the Flagpole along the east fence line
- 2. At the shelter in place points
  - a. inside the lodge,
    - b. In Camp Ops, the second floor of The Gathering Centre

In the event of an emergency take the following steps:

- 1. Notice the event, speak it out loud until another Camper hears you.
  - a. For Example, yelling 'Medic!' 'Fire!' or 'Help!'
- 2. Notify people around the scene prior to leaving it.
- 3. Seek out or send someone to seek out a staff member.
- Notify any around the scene that staff are on the way, remove yourself and others from hazards if safe – if unsure, remove yourself only.
- 5. Be available for debrief at the end of the emergency.

If directed by staff to assist, you have the right to refuse if you do not feel comfortable. Decline politely and ask if you can go find more people to help. If directed by staff to leave an area, you must do so immediately and safely even if you do not understand why.

#### PaH Patrol



The Pah Patrol are volunteers that will be walking the grounds, identifiable by their reflective vests.

PaH Patrol will also periodically patrol the forest

paths and call out "PaH Patrol!" at the four corners of the forest. If you need assistance, yell back.

They will be picking up discarded/ lost items, checking on the various amenities and discarding any food/drinks that has been abandoned or left out.

If you are missing an item after midnight, chances are that it is in the lost and found located in Camp Operations on the second floor of the Gathering Centre – permission is required to enter.

To avoid having any of your stuff ending up in lost and found or the garbage please ensure all your belongings are stored in your tent/room/RV and your food/drinks are in the cooler room before midnight.

#### **Recreational Substance Use**



- Be respectful in your behaviour.
- No glass drinking containers on the grounds
- If you can buy it legally in Alberta, you can consume it on grounds.

If consuming tobacco via combustion, do so along The Gathering Centre wall facing the marsh. You may not smoke around the Campfires or while wandering through the grounds. We understand this may be a hassle for some, but this is to respect the health and comfort of our fellow Campers, many of whom deal with asthma.

Vaping on the grounds follows provincial regulations, not within 10 meters or 33 feet of any door, vent, or building opening. Do so respectfully

with the consent of those around you. Don't force people to inhale your exhaust, your rights to consume don't trump others peaceful enjoyment. Respect requests to relocate or cease.

# **Gathering Centre**



The gathering center is located on the northern side of the property near the wetlands. This area is the hub of Camp and where Wruffin'It

meals are made and eaten. It's where the Trainer's dinner is held and where some panels take place. It is also where the dungeon and two of the bathrooms are located. The Gathering center is open 24 hrs. Please bring your butt blanket to sit on the furniture.

Camp ops is in the Gathering Center on the second floor. You can get extra condoms and lube here as well. If you need anything from Camp Ops find Papa Bear, PapaWuff, Pup Toy or Pup Rath.

# **Camp Store**



The Camp store sells items like douche bulbs, towels, toothbrushes, Camp branded swag like pins, Gatorade, pop, and other items you may have forgotten

behind. You may pay via cash, tap, debit, or credit as you see fit. Wruffin'It also accepts all the branded tap to pay systems. Purchases are being trialed on the honour system this year.

## Fire Pits



There are two fire pits for use. One is on the east side of the Gathering Center near the Hayshed and the other is on the west side near the Quite Camp area.

Campfires, if conditions allow, are maintained by our Campfire warden. Please seek out Pup Maxell if you wish to start or quash a Campfire or have any issues with them, he is ultimately responsible for

them. Fire suppression equipment is placed close to all Campfires, please do not relocate or play with it.

# Hay Shed



The Hayshed is in the center of Camp where the hammocks and some of the learning panels take place. Field toys can be found here as well and are free to use whenever

you like. Hammocks are on a first come first serve basis. Give priority to scheduled activities and use respectfully.

#### **Forest Finds**



Forest finds are outdoor play areas that are unmonitored and away from the high traffic Camp areas. They are perfect for that romantic rendezvous

or to create social media content. We won't say anymore about that. It's an adventure. Please clean up our equipment after playing.

# Hygiene



Hey Musky Puppy! We love you and are glad you're here. Keep a nose on your scents, if you're bordering on offensive, staff may ask you to go

wash and tone it down.

Those who are padded are asked to keep their padding covered when not in dl spaces/panels, and no messing. We recognize that padded pups are a growing trend, and we'd also like to acknowledge that several people have triggers surrounding the whole motif. We will leave it to Campers to respectfully self advocate as needed.

Campers are also required to use a towel or such when sitting on indoor furniture, the Camp store has a selection of butt towels for sale if you wish.

# Hyrdrant Hounds Spray Park



The Hydrant Hounds Spray Park is located behind the Cauldron and is considered an extreme fetish area. If you are triggered by Watersports play do not enter this area. Please

use hose and spray wand to clean area after usage.

The mutt mister is located just off the eastern corner of Gathering center and can be use 24hrs. Pull gently on the chain.

# **Camp Cauldron**



The Caldron is located just behind the Mutt Mister in the big tent and can be used 24hrs. Rinse before and after entering for best hygiene. **Do** 

**not soap up in the shower before getting into the hot tubs.** If you need to wash down, do so, then return in 15 minutes to rinse off again.

The cauldron can accommodate up to 12 pups (if you hold your breath). The water temperatures may vary throughout the day, but we ask that you do not play with the propane or pump. *The cauldron is left cool during the day* so feel free to take a dip to cool down. We begin heating it at dinner for evening use. If there is a problem or you would like the water hotter, please find Papa Bear.

## Lodge Hot Tub



This hot tub is located outside the lodge on the south side of and is available to everyone. Please take a rinsing shower before entering and

do not overflow the hot tub. 5 people max, cover when not in use. If at any time water begins spilling over the edge, there are too many people. If the water falls below the intake points (you'll hear it), fill it up or seek out a staff member or a member of the venue team to refill it.

Lazy M provides towels to lodge guests – if you're not staying in the lodge, we suggest you bring your

own. Avoid grey or brown towels, if possible, as Lazy M's towels are mostly grey, with some brown variations.

# **Bridge and Creek**



The Bridge and Creek are accessible down the western trail head through Quiet Camp or down the stairway behind the house. The creek is a popular fishing area so if you want to

go swimming, we advise using the magnetic wands to clear the area of fishhooks and to wear footwear in the water. Fishing is catch and release and requires a provincial licence. **Do not cross on to the other side of the bridge as that is private property.** 

# Labyrinth



The Labyrinth is located north of the house through the trees. Please watch for power cords as the labyrinth will be fitted with black

lights on the hillside for a night-time display. Feel free to use the labyrinth as a peaceful meditation area, or quiet play space.

## **Cuddle Cabin**



The Cuddle Cabin is located down the southern trail and is open 24hours. You can chill, yiff, whatever, but you may not sleep in there. Make sure you clean up and dispose of all

messes. It's quiet and secluded. If it's occupied ask if it's okay to come in, respect a no if you receive one and return later. Do not dominate the space.

#### Media Creation & Distribution



Media Creation & Distribution at Wruffin'It is consent-based. Wruffin'It photographers wear badges marked with "PHOTO".

Green Tyvek wristbands indicate consent for photography; remove them by pulling from underneath if you don't want to be photographed. We discourage phone use for privacy but allow personal content shots.

This year we're going to try something new. If you take photos at Camp, only people wearing green consent wrist bands may appear in your photos and you must seek their consent before sharing them anywhere. Don't guess, if you don't know who they are, ask. This is an issue of consent and people's privacy and livelihoods.

Violators will be banned from Camp, no exceptions. If you don't intend on complying, don't take the photo, the Pod has agreed to a zero-tolerance policy for violations to allow for this compromise. We want you to have fun, to express yourself, to share Camp with the world. Y'all exhibitionists, we get it, but respect consent.

# The Board's Board of Boards



The Board's Board of Boards is the information nerve center for Camp Wruffin'It and is located at The Gathering Centre. Here you can check out what activities are coming up, see when you need to volunteer on the Doody Roster, view the day's weather forecast and draw art or leave messages free play signup board.
